For those who cannot attend the Holiday Joy Drive Event, Nemours Children's will accept holiday donations between 9 a.m.- 6 p.m each day between <u>November 25th and December 20th</u>. Donations will be received at the main atrium entrance. The latest the hospital can accept holiday toy donations is noon Dec. 20.

Gifts cannot be accepted from Dec. 21-Jan. 3. Drop-offs will resume on Jan. 3 at the main hospital tower entrance. Due to patient confidentiality and infection control, any donated items will be distributed by Nemours staff only.

We cannot accept used items. Please do not donate any toy guns, food, candy, or any items that are breakable, sharp or contain latex. Please do not gift wrap toys; however, we are happy to receive donations of wrapping supplies along with the toys!

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What kinds of donations makes the largest impact?

Your financial contributions make the greatest and most immediate impact on our patients and families. 2. What's the most needed items right now in the hospital?

Our most needed items include:

- Infant items: rattles, teethers, o-balls, binkies, musical & light up toys, boppy pillows, etc.
- Play-Doh (tubs, sets, & cutting tools)
- \$25 Gift Cards for Amazon, Target, Walmart, etc. (in amounts of \$25)
- Children and adult coloring books and artist sketch pads
- Crayola crayons (24 count), washable markers and colored pencils (sets of 8-24)
- Teen and tech items including Bluetooth speakers and headphones and advanced crafts
- New stuffed animals with their tags attached
- Uno, board games, teen card games and decks of playing cards
- Crafts kits for school-age children and teens: art sets, science kits, STEM building, etc.
- Sensory balls and toys, Pop its, Find It Games. Please note: All donations must be new in its original packaging, including attached tags.

3. Are there items that you cannot accept?

Out of concern for the safety, immunity and allergies of many of our patients, we are only able to accept new items with the tags still attached. We are unable to accept the following donations:

Toys

- Used/previously played with items, toys, books, games or stuffed animals
- Latex toys, games and balloons
- Collections of items, toys, books, games or stuffed animals that have never been played with but have been stored away or are vintage collectables
- Full-sized sports equipment (soccer, basketballs, nets, etc.), bikes, skateboards, scooters
- Toys that resemble weapons (swords, violent action figures, etc.)

Other Items

- Displays or art work intended for use or display in the hospital
- Handwritten cards, messages or letters for patients and families
- Handmade/sewn clothing
- Homemade food/treats (cookies, cupcakes, bars, etc.)
- Used medical equipment

4. Can I deliver my donation directly to the children?

Due to patient confidentiality and infection control, donors are not able to deliver gifts to our patients. We are also not able to provide pictures with patients in them once a donation is received.
